About ACRS

The Arkansas Consumer Report System (ACRS) was developed in response to the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998. The ACRS system provides post-secondary education and training providers with an internet application in which they can enter information about programs they provide to potential students, both WIA and non-WIA eligible. These providers can also use the ACRS system to generate WIA Training Provider applications in order to become certified Eligible Training Providers.

Local Workforce Investment Boards (LWIB) can use the system to review applications and assign an approval status. State level users at Arkansas Workforce/LMI can use the system to oversee operations by education and training providers and LWIBs. State level users also have the administrative responsibilities of the system in which new providers are added, state and local performance standards are entered, and general data maintenance functions are performed.

The general public can access ACRS in order to gather information about post-secondary institutions and training programs in the state of Arkansas. Links to related WIA information will be available to all ACRS users.




Some ACRS screens have a button at the bottom of the page for printing. Clicking this button allows the page to be printed using the browser Print function.

Multiple Page List Navigation

All List screens in ACRS will display no more than 10 records per page. When a list has more than one page, links will appear at the bottom of the list for navigating to other list pages.

The following links will appear at the bottom of the list:

- Previous – Links to the Previous Page of the List
- Page # # # - Links to specific pages of the List
- Next – Links to the Next Page of the List

The fact that a program is not certified under WIA does not imply that it is not an education-certified program.

General inquiries regarding information provided on the Statewide List of Eligible Training Providers for programs in your area should be directed to the Local Workforce Investment Board (LWIB). For contact information, go to the Local Workforce Investment Area (LWIA).

Inclusion of information regarding any program of training services or any institution, organization or individual providing training services is in no way an endorsement by the Department of Workforce Services (DWS) of that program, institution, organization or individual. The Department has included in this list information provided to it by Local Workforce Investment Boards (LWIBs) and training providers and does not guarantee the accuracy of the information. Viewers are requested to report to their LWIBs and DWS any inaccuracies found in the information. For specific information or inquiry regarding WIA eligible training providers, contact DWS.

General

Information is provided for programs or courses that have received certification by a Local Workforce Investment Board and the Department of Workforce Services. Certification and inclusion on these lists is based on data submitted to Local Boards by the training providers applying for certification under the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of 1998. Training providers are subject to removal from the Statewide List of Eligible Training Providers if they intentionally supply inaccurate information. Viewers are encouraged to review the list prior to enrolling in a program or course to ensure that the training provider is certified to enroll persons with a WIA Individual Training Account.

Training providers who offer programs or courses under the same field of study are listed in alphabetical order. The order of listing does not reflect any preference on the part of a Local Workforce Investment Board or the Department of Workforce Services. Viewers who will be using a WIA Individual Training Account are encouraged to review the data on each program or course in consultation with their Arkansas Department of Workforce Services Center case manager.

If a training provider has voluntarily provided additional contact information, electronic linkages to external websites are available to help you access additional information that may be important to you when choosing your training option. No effort is made by the Department of Workforce Services or the Local Workforce Investment Boards to validate any information in the training providers' websites.

Performance

The Workforce Investment Act requires certain training providers to submit performance information when applying for inclusion on the Statewide List of Eligible Training Providers. The performance information is self-reported by the providers.

To remain on the Statewide List, training providers are required to meet annual performance goals. The information used for the renewal process is collected and reviewed by the Local Workforce Investment Boards. This information should help viewers make informed choices when selecting a training provider.



A comprehensive educational consumer report system should provide data for six crucial areas: schools and programs of study; follow-up data on former students; occupational exploration; job hunting resources; labor market information; and skills exploration and testing. ACRS offers links for all six areas below.

The information provided is neutral; your needs, desires and abilities determine what is useful in your decision-making process. A large school seems attractive to someone who craves the excitement of crowds, for example. Such a school would be less desirable to someone who favors the intimacy of a smaller setting. Maybe intercollegiate athletics and sporting events on campus are important to you. Or, perhaps, you are more interested in the availability of financial aid. These links in ACRS should help provide a more complete picture of your options.

The What's New Screen

The What's New screen contains information about the new ACRS system and information about changes to the system.

What's New

Previous users of the Arkansas Consumer Report System (ACRS) will notice the new look of the web site. Although it may look different, the functionality of the previous system has been retained. New features have been added that make the site more user-friendly.

From the Main Page users can access the following links:

Providers

Clicking on "Providers" presents the user with several choices. The options chosen determine the presentation of the list the user views. First, choose "All Providers" or "Eligible Providers". If "All Providers" is chosen, all providers will be listed. If "Eligible Providers" is chosen, only those providers that are WIA-Certified will be listed. Optionally, to narrow the search, a user may enter a Keyword; choose a Provider Type and/or a Local Workforce Investment Area. A user may select "All LWIA" and providers for the entire State will be displayed, or one or more LWIAs may be selected to view providers for that area only. Once the Providers results are displayed, a user may click on the "Provider Listing" tab to obtain an alphabetical list of Providers.

Programs

Clicking on "Programs" presents the user with several choices. The options chosen determine the presentation of the list the user views. First, choose "All Providers" or "Eligible Providers". If "All Providers" is chosen, all programs will be listed. If "Eligible Providers" is chosen, only those programs that are WIA-Certified will be listed. Optionally, to narrow the search, a user may enter a Keyword; choose a Field of Study, Training Level, Local Workforce Investment Area, Maximum Cost, and/or Financial Aid available. A user may select "All LWIA" and programs for the entire State will be displayed, or one or more LWIAs may be selected to view programs for that area only. Once the Programs results are displayed, a user may click on the "Program Listing" tab to obtain an alphabetical list of Programs.

WIA Eligible Youth Providers

Clicking on "WIA Eligible Youth Providers" will allow the user to select a Local Workforce Investment Area and view its approved list of youth service providers.

Projected Employment Opportunities List

Clicking on the "Projected Employment Opportunities List" will allow the user to determine the programs of study that can lead to employment in occupations that are in demand. Courses listed on the statewide list should provide opportunities for employment anywhere within the State, while those listed for a particular Local Workforce Investment Area only apply to that particular area. This guide serves to fulfill two needs: first, it is useful to potential students seeking training, and secondly, it provides information to educational providers who wish to make application to become a WIA Eligible Training Provider. One of the criteria for a program of study to be declared WIA-certified is that it provides training for an occupation considered to be in demand either statewide or in a LWIA.

From the Home Page users can login using the following link:

Registered Users Login Here

Clicking on "Registered Users Login Here" will allow registered users with the proper Username and Password to obtain access to their own data. They may change certain provider data (i.e., address, contact person), add or modify program data, and make an initial or subsequent WIA Training Provider application. Local Workforce Investment Boards can change their Board's information (i.e., address, contact person), review WIA Eligible Training Provider applications, and assign an application status (approved/rejected).



Search Tips:


- If you know the name of the Provider you are searching for, type it into the Keywords search field. You can also search based on partial names. For example, searching for “arkansas” will search for any Provider whose name begins with “arkansas”.




Keywords

Name, partial name, letter, etc.

- Search options are not case sensitive
- The more search options are entered, the narrower your search results will be.
- To perform another search and clear your search options, click the Reset Criteria button near the bottom of the screen.



- To search using a visual map of the state of Arkansas, click on the View Map link under the Local Workforce Investment Areas option. Then click on the section of the state where you are looking for Providers. The system will automatically select the appropriate check box for that section of the map.

The Provider Listing Screen

The Provider Listing screen displays all Providers in the system in ascending sequence by Provider Name. You may click on the letter in the alphabetic ‘jump’ menu and the system will jump you to the section of the Provider List where Provider Names start with the letter chosen. For example, clicking on the ‘R’ will navigate you to the beginning of the Provider List where Provider Name begins with ‘R’.

The default list is sorted by ascending Provider name but you may sort the list by other options including Area Name, City, State, and Zip code. To do this, click the arrow down or up beside the desired option name in the column near the top.

Clicking on the Provider Name will navigate you to the Provider Details screen as discussed above.

Clicking on letter directs you to Providers with names starting with that letter

Clicking on down/up arrow resorts the Provider Listing in that sequence

The Program Listing Screen

The Program Listing screen displays all Programs in the system in ascending sequence by Program Name. You may click on the letter in the alphabetic ‘jump’ menu and the system will jump you to the section of the Program List where Program Names start with the letter chosen. For example, clicking on the ‘R’ will navigate you to the beginning of the Program List where Program Name begins with ‘R’.

The default list is sorted by ascending Program name but you may sort the list by other options including Area Name, Training Level, Provider Name, City, and State. To do this, click the arrow down or up beside the desired option name in the column near the top.

Clicking on the Program Name will navigate you to the Program Details screen as discussed above.

Clicking on letter directs you to Programs with names starting with that letter

Clicking on down/up arrow resorts the Program Listing in that sequence

Clicking on Program Name directs you to Program Details screen
